Lessons learned - A SPICOP instructed a PS to remove work site marker boards without ES instruction.

RECENT INCIDENT OVERVIEW



What Happened?

A PICOP instructed a PS to remove work site marker boards (WSMBs) even though the PS had not received a direct instruction from the ES, as required by the Rule Book.

CAUSE

- It had become custom and practice on some areas for the (S)PICOPs to instruct PS workers to place / remove WSMBs without including the ES in any communications.



LESSONS LEARNED

- Possession support staff must not place or remove work site marker boards (WSMBs) without receiving a direct verbal instruction from the Engineering Supervisor (ES).
- If the (S)PICOP (or anyone else who is not the ES) instructs a PS to place or remove WSMBs then the PS must ask the PICOP to request the ES to contact the PS directly so that the ES can give the PS the WSMB placement / removal instructions personally over the phone.
- These rules must be followed in all circumstances.
